3. An all-inclusive **conference registration for DAC** (value: up to \$920). You can attend all sessions, keynotes, receptions and awards. Your access to any workshops and tutorials is included.
4. Young Fellow welcome **breakfast** on Sunday Morning June 7th 7:30-9:00am at Moscone Center,

Room #307 (Esplanade area). You will meet your colleagues and members of the DAC Executive Committee.

5. Young Fellow **poster presentations**, collocated with the Ph.D. Form on Tuesday evening.
6. **Closing session** on Thursday evening (6:00pm during closing reception), where you will receive your A. Richard Newton Young Fellow certificate and your award money. Only people present at the closing ceremony will receive their checks.
7. A priceless experience in San Francisco, the city by the Bay.
